

ORDER RECOUNT IN VOTE PROBE

CHICAGO, July 22, (AP)—A complete recount of the vote cast in Cook county (Chicago) for the United States senatorial nomination in both republican and democratic parties was ordered today by County Judge Jarocki, at the request of Senator James A. Reed, chairman of the senate campaign expenditure committee.

The court acted as true bills reported to have been voted against fifty four judges and clerks of election in the April primaries, were awaited in the criminal court.

Senator Reed sought the aid of the county court in determining how the senatorial ballots were handled as his committee prepared to assemble here Monday for an inquiry into the senatorial primaries.

Lack of Flowers on Mothers' Day Cause of Probe

LOS ANGELES, July 22.—(AP)—Flowers that failed to reach a gray-haired mother on Mother's Day were responsible for the investigation which resulted in the arrest Monday night in New York of Rev. Phillip Goodwin as a murder suspect.

Joseph J. Patterson, for whose death Goodwin is being held, failed for the first time last Mother's Day, May 9, to send a gift of flowers and a greeting to his mother at Miami,

Arizona. This and the fact that his correspondence with his brother had stopped abruptly prompted the investigation which led to the discovery of the murderer and Goodwin's subsequent arrest.

Patterson's body was found at Santa Ana on March 22, in a river bed where it had been dragged and set afloat.

T. B. Inspection Nearly Complete

Under the supervision of Dr. G. H. Thompson of the U. S. Bureau of Animal Industry, Portland, the Tuberculosis test of Klamath cattle is progressing in splendid shape according to C. A. Henderson, county agent.

About 500 dairy cattle have been tested thus far in the eastern part of the county including the districts of Hly, Bonanza, Langell Valley, and Oleo, and not one animal so

far has reacted to the serum injections.

This week Dr. Thompson is inspecting the herds in the main floor of the valley in the vicinity of Merrill and Malin.
