Now, the court has called for a showdown—a very proper thing to do. Let the taxpayers know the whole story, and this is the way to have it divulged.

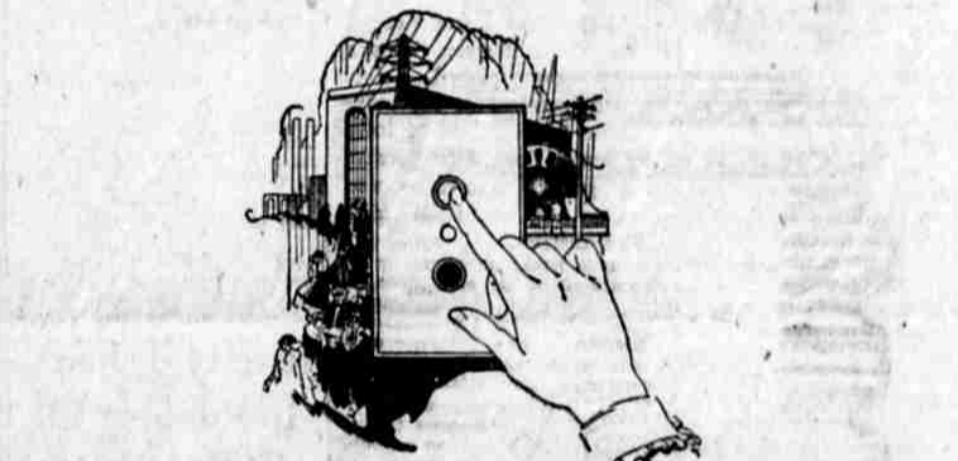
AT THE LIBERTY
