"Long Distance, Please Give Me England," New Service To Be Initiated Next Saturday

Telephone service from this and other Pacific Coast cities will become available Saturday, February 26, across the American continent and across the Atlantic Ocean to England.

The announcement is made today by General Manager C. E. Hickman of the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company in Washington, Oregon and Idaho. The arrangement is in conjunction with the American Telephone and Telegraph Company which handles the trans-Atlantic connections.

It represents the final step in extension of trans-Atlantic service throughout the forty-eight states. Since the opening event January 7, connecting only the Metropolitan areas of London and New York, as the beginning, the territory on each side of the Atlantic has been gradually extended until now it covers all of England, Scotland and Wales, and with this connection to be made Saturday, all of the main body of the United States, Canada is not included.

Opens Saturday.
Saturday morning the states of Oregon, Washington, California, Nevada and Arizona will gain access to this new service. They are in the fifth, or final zone, of the country. The mountain states of Montana, Idaho, Wyoming, Utah and Colorado, together with Texas and New Mexico, were brought into the service as the fourth zone earlier this week.

Twenty-four hours before, the service becomes available calls will be accepted at any long distance office of the Pacific Telephone System in this state or opening event Saturday, will be Washington for London or elsewhere in England, Scotland or Wales. These calls will be listed
