U. S. To Send Big Team To Olympics

NEW YORK, April 8.—(AP)—The United States will send a team of 300 to 350 athletes to the 1928 Olympics at Amsterdam, Holland, chartering an ocean liner that will be used as a hotel while the games are in progress.

This solution of the housing problems was decided on today by the executive committee of the American Olympic committee, which also laid plans to raise between \$200,000 and \$300,000 to cover the expenses of the athletic invasion.
