STATE DEMANDS DEATH FOR HUGH

Statements Attributed to De Autremont Recited in Opening Statement

COURT HOUSE, JACKSONVILLE, Ore., June 13. (AP)—The sixth day Autremont pay with his life, for the murder of four men during the progress of the Siskiyou tunnel hold-up, was the closing sentence of the opening statement of special prosecutor George M. Roberts, this morning.

The defendant on trial for the murder of Charles O. (Coyle) Johnson, his father's hand upon his shoulder, betrayed no emotion, and turned to comfort his mother as the court recessed pending the opening remarks of the defense.

Proseutor Roberts told the jury that following the banditry, Hugh, after his arrest in the Philippines, and during his incarceration at Alcatraz Island prison, told the authorities that after the attempted robbery he had fled to San Francisco then to Los Angeles thence to Texas and from there to Chicago, where during the progress of a raid on a tenderloin resort, a policeman had placed a hand upon his arm and advised him to leave as he was too young to be arrested.

The special prosecutor declared that when his mother visited him in prison, after his return to the United States, she urged him to tell all, and he had replied:

"No, no, mother. Don't let them talk you into that."

It was further declared that when the mother asked regarding an alibi, the defendant said:

"I haven't any, but I have a weird story to tell the jury, that with the aid of a good lawyer, they will believe."

Another statement attributed to the state to the defendant to his mother was:

"Mother dear, you never thought your 19 year old boy would go wrong, but I didn't mean to do it."

The state outlined the details of the three score bits of mule evidence in the vicinity of the crime, by an army of investigators.

"All these exhibits go by the rule of three—three knapsacks, three beds, three overcoats. But there were only two things. The evidence will disclose the reason for this," said special prosecutor. Paraphrase of articles in Eugene and Portland, Oregon, later found at the bandits' camps, near the tunnel, were outlined by the state. The names and parts played by Ray and Roy De Autremont, jointly accused of participation, and now under arrest in Ohio, were frequently mentioned in the statement.

For many years before the arrival of a doctor in the Bonanza country, Mrs. James was the first thought of in emergencies. She was known throughout the county for her solicitations.

Married in 1869.

She was married in El Dorado Springs, Missouri, in 1869, and to the union were born four daughters, Mrs. Mary Ousley of Silver Lake, Oregon, Mrs. I. J. Fordney of Lorrington and Mrs. Edna Chase of Ella, Oregon, Mrs. Edna Bunn of Bonanza. Eight grandchildren and seven great grandchildren also survive.

Different from many older people, Mrs. James always looked forward to the future years and was active up until her fatal illness which brought the end after a week's suffering.

Mrs. James was a prominent member of the Baptist church for more than 57 years and was active in all civic affairs. The funeral services will be held at the Bonanza church on Thursday morning at ten o'clock. The remains are in the slumber room of the T. J. Mortuary.
