CHICAGO CUBS CLOSE TO TOP

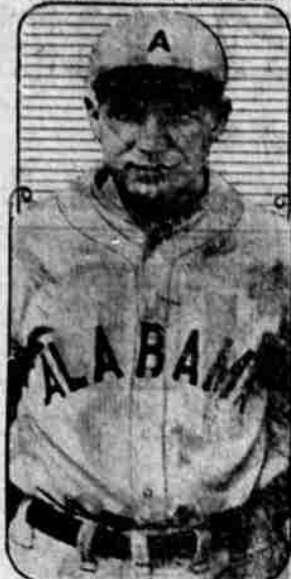
Pirates' Position At Top Of
National League Is In
Jeopardy

The climbing Cubs ascended today within a single game of the Pirates at the top of the National League ladder.

In games won the Cubs tied the Pirates with a mark of 32 by beating the Giants, 4 to 3. The last ten of the victories have been consecutive and the last four have been at the expense of the Giants for a clean sweep of the series. Since the Cubs have played two more games than the Pirates and lost two more they still are a few points behind them.

Western teams made a clean sweep of the day's games. There were only three as rain was general in the east and cancelled all the American league games. In addition to Chicago, the winners were the Cardinals and Reds. The world champions, in third place, continued to stay very much in the running for the pennant by sweeping clean a four game series with the Phillies. The fourth victory was won at 6 to 4.

stride, best fitted for the straight-away running.

Need More Than Speed
Sheer speed alone doesn't make a great baserunner. Speed is merely one of the factors.

I could name perhaps a dozen ball players, who I am sure could step 100 yards in close to 10 seconds, yet who are far from being good baserunners.

Speed is a great help in getting to first. Likewise, it is a decided advantage in trying to do the limit on an extra base hit. Still, speed doesn't necessarily mean that the player possessing it is above the ordinary as a baserunner.

The ability to take a commanding lead, then get the break with the pitcher, ending the attempt with a deceptive slide, are three other things aside from speed that a clever baserunner must have.

In truth, some of the best baserunners in the history of baseball have been players with only average speed but highly-developed in the other attributes.

Views of Moriarty
There is George Moriarty, now

manager of the Detroit Tigers, who has also served as a big league player and umpire. While far from a speed merchant, Moriarty in his day as a player was one of the most skilled baserunners I have ever followed around the paths.

A good lead at the right spot make a good base-runner more than all the speed in the world, Moriarty says.

In stealing home, those two elements enter more strongly than in the theft of second or third.

When I tell you that Moriarty stole home successfully in 15 out of 17 consecutive attempts over a period of two years, you will realize what I am driving at in depreciating the extraordinary value of speed in the makeup of a great baserunner.

Off on the wrong foot this spring, the Tigers have been unable to cut up on the bases as Moriarty had hoped they would. Maybe they will later.

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Dempsey Will Fight Sharkey on July 21st

NEW YORK, June 15. (AP)—Jack Dempsey's drive to win back the title he lost, is to begin July 21, in a battle with Jack Sharkey at the Yankee stadium here. Tex Rickard has spoken. When he and Sharkey together attended a boxing show at the Brooklyn navy yard last night, he broke the news.

One of the most delighted fans present was Sharkey, who learned to fight aboard a Man O' War. Sharkey is sure he can lick Dempsey or Tunney himself for that matter. The winner of this fray is to have the coveted chance to meet the champion for the title. The "fighting marine" has started light training in preparation for its defense in September.

Rickard added the information that Dempsey would come east at once and take over his old training quarters at Saratoga, N. Y.

Such figures would make it appear as if Frisch was much the faster man, yet in reality such is far from being the case. As a matter of fact, Hornaby recently challenged Frisch to meet him in a 100-yard dash to determine the dispute definitely.
