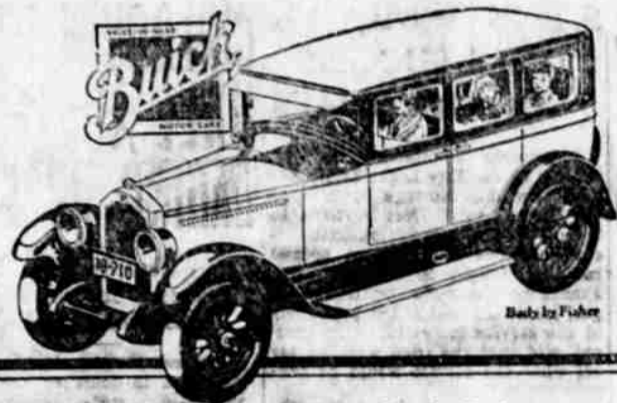

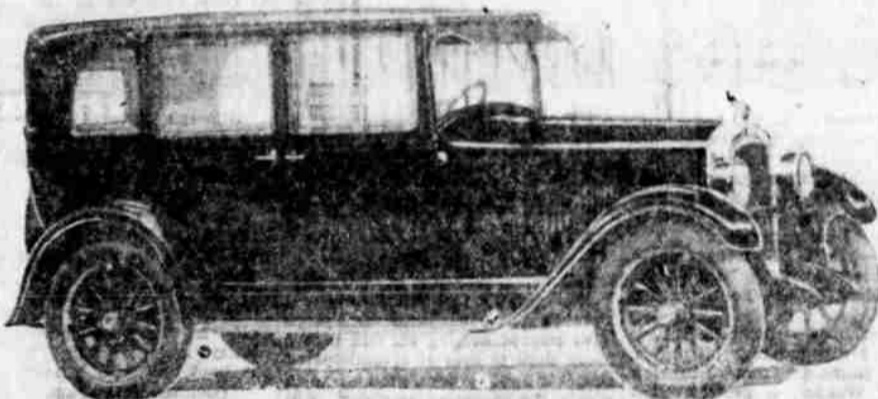
How Territory is Divided

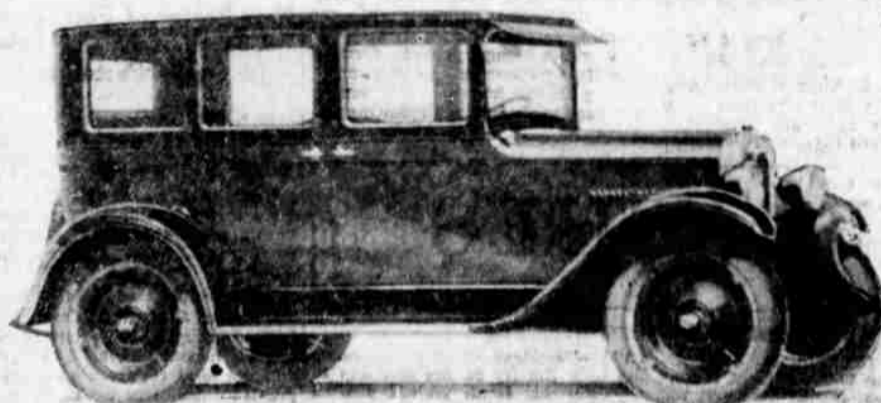
