

# DE AUTREMONTS ARE ADMITTED TO STATE PRISON

"On one condition," interjected Ray De Autremont, "that you send me to my wife."

He gave the newspaper man the address of his wife, Hazel De Autremont, in Hanging Rock, Ohio, a girl whom he married about a year ago, and who until his arrest did not know she was married to a criminal.

Officers said the three boys were jolly on the train last night, and that apparently their only regret was that they were captured. They talked a great deal until after midnight, and then slept for two or three hours.

"The boys talked freely about the crime while on the train," said Sheriff Jennings. "They reviewed the whole thing, answered all questions and talked without being questioned. Most of the time I simply sat and listened to them. It was like a dime novel."

"Ray, they said, wanted to commit suicide, but Roy and Hugh say they talked him out of it. They reminded him of other famous criminal gangs that had fought to the end, and declared they wanted to go out the same way."

They were far from a jolly trio of brothers when they entered the prison gate at 5:30 this morning. Hugh, the younger, the debonaire, the boy who throughout his trial defied all efforts to break him, was the most nervous of the three when they were ushered into the turnkey's office this morning. He is only 23 but he looked twice that age, with face pale and lined after three years of what he himself has described as "hell."

**Few Words Spoken**  
The boys had nothing to say while they were changing their clothing for prison attire. Only Ray spoke a few words to an officer relative to some of his belongings. Once Hugh whispered to the officer to whom he was shackled.

As the boys sat stripped in the turnkey's office, an officer pointed to the big toe on Ray's left foot.

"There is one of Ray's identification marks," he said.

The toenail was black from some old injury. Ray bleached his hair in Steubeville with peroxide, but he failed to change the color of the toenail—and it seems that Uncle Sam often notices details.

**Cells To Be Assigned**  
The lads were in time for breakfast at the prison, and it was expected they would be allowed to go to the dining room with the other convicts after being assigned to their cells.

Supt. Henry W. Myers said he would put the three at hard labor in the lime and flax plants of the prison. "I understand they have been working in steel, and they ought to be able to stand hard work," said Myers.

Myers, Warden James W. Lewis, Deputy Warden Gene Halley, Turnkey Clark and several other prison officials received the trio. Accompanying them from southern Oregon were Sheriff R. G. Jennings and Deputy W. E. Morris from Medford; O. W. Dunford, jailer at Jacksonville; and W. D. Miles and J. H. McClaine, special agents of the Southern Pacific.
