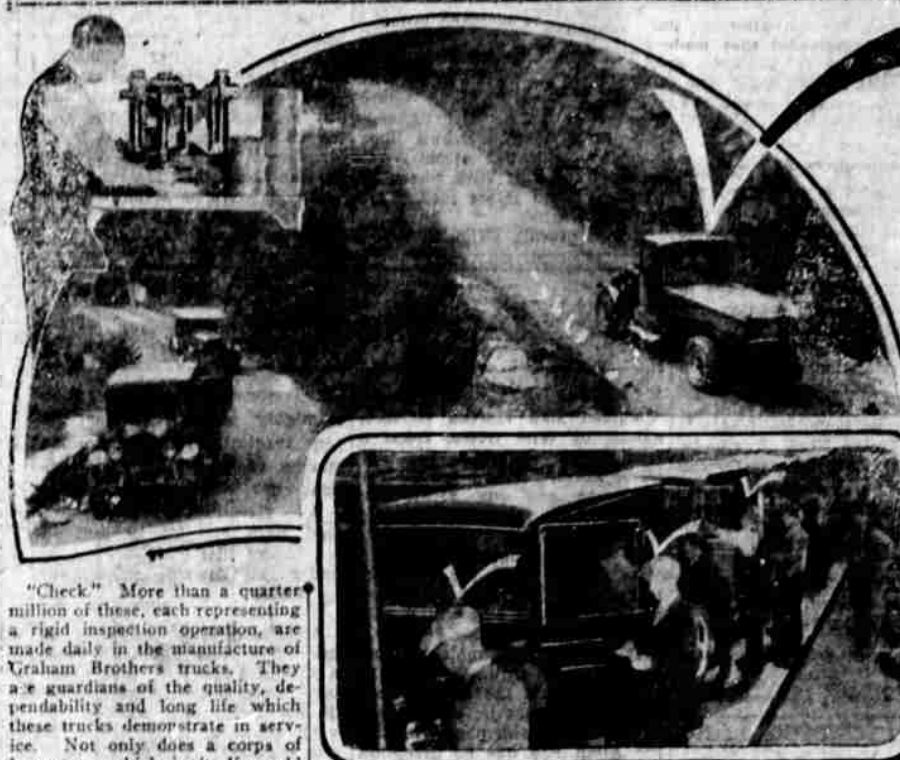

BERLIN, (AP)—The twenty-four hour clock, recently installed throughout the German railways system and in the Reichstag, has a hard time winning the favor of the populace.

At a meeting of the Berlin watch makers one enterprising firm reported that it had devised a dial on which, at midday, the figures 1 to 12 disappear and the numbers 13 to 24 come up in their place.

This firm also canvassed public opinion in middle and southern Germany, and found that the conservative provincial population not only rejects the new watch but declines to say "half past thirteen" or "twenty-three o'clock."
