\$2,500 a thousand, the total price would be \$625,000.

Charles Bray and Mrs. Hazel Bray are a brother and sister of William H. Bray, prominent Klamath lumberman.

The trio formerly were principal stockholders in the Oshkosh Timber company. Approximately one-half of the holdings of the company were recently decided by the company to Charles Bray and Hazel Bray, and, almost immediately after, the deal with Hovey was closed.

The timber has been in the Bray family for over 15 years. It was originally owned by the firm of Bray & Choate of Duluth, Wis. Prior to the elder Mr. Bray's death, he acquired all of the holdings of Mr. Choate, his partner.

Inherit Timber

Through inheritance, the timber eventually came into the hands of the three Bray children, William, Charles and Hazel. William H. Bray moved to Klamath and is an active lumber operator with a mill at Brayville, on Sprague river.

As the chief stockholder of the Oshkosh Timber company he is still the owner of large holdings in the Keno district, and westward.

The timber is recognized as exceptionally fine and is not beetle infested to any extent. It is located on the watershed of Jenny Creek.

In the interview with the elder Mr. Hovey, the Associated Press representative failed to ascertain whether or not Louis Walker, son of T. H. Walker, famous timber baron, was a joint purchaser of the tract. It has been reliably reported that such was the case.

The rising of the Merrimack and Penobscot rivers flooded 30 houses, the Sullivan mills and many business establishments and forced hundreds to leave their homes.

BURLINGTON, Vt., Nov. 5. (A. P.)—Efforts to employ an airplane here today to reach Rutland were reported to have perished in the flood, proved fruitless, the only plane in this section being in Milton, which was shifted off from the outside world.

Highways as well as railroads and wire service to this town were crippled.
