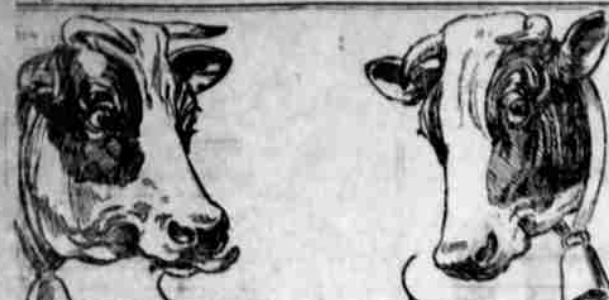

materially changed," he said.
"These mills estimated what
their cut would be by the end of
the year."

Included in the report were
not only 26 major lumber opera-
tions of Klamath county but al-
so six mills of northern Califor-
nia, north of Weed, which are
properly included in the Klamath
basin territory.

The big three in the Klamath
basin proved to be the Polican
Bay lumber company with a to-
tal of 65,000,000 feet; the Ewauna
Box company with 62,000,000
feet; and the Forest Lumber com-
pany of Pine Ridge with 40,000,000
feet.

Other large cuts included the
Shaw Hertram Lumber company
with 35,000,000 feet; the Bray-
mill White Pine company with
21,000,000 feet; the Lamm Lum-
ber company with 20,000,000
feet; and the Chiloquin Lumber com-
pany with 18,000,000 feet.

The Weyerhaeuser Portab-
le

mills which have been salvaging
partly burned timber west of
Klamath Falls, cut 14,000,000
feet.

WINTER CLOSING MCKENZIE PASS

McKenzie Pass is closed for
the winter.

This was the official word
sent out by the Oregon State Mo-
tor Association today. Since
Thursday morning 14 additional
inches of snow have fallen on the
pass. While the road could have
been kept open with the use of
the rotary plow, demand for the
use of the pass has been so slight
that officials deemed it advisable
to close it for the winter.

The highway from Bend to
Burns has been closed on account
of the heavy snow fall. On the
Old Oregon trail a heavy snow
fall in the Blue Mountains is re-
ported, but the road is still open
for travel. Cars are getting
through without difficulty.
Fresh snow is reported on
Sand Creek Summit, but the
highway is open from Bend to
Klamath Falls.

ing two guards at each entrance
to the senate chamber and loung-
ing room.

Senator C. H. Terwilliger of
Tulsa went to the capitol shortly
after the troops were stationed
at senate doors. The guardsmen
said they would admit the sena-
tor to the chambers, but they
had orders to allow no house
members to pass in.
