MANAGUA, Nicaragua, Jan. 28. (AP)—American marines today were on the peak of El Chipote and the last traces of the rebel general Augustino Sandino's occupation of this, his last known stronghold, has been destroyed.

From the crest of El Chipote, Major Archibald Young, who led the marines in their advance, signalled all was well with them.

Victory, indicating that the rebels had fled in haste leaving their dead unburied, were the only signs of life seen by marines who flew over the district later.
