

SCHOOL PUPILS GIVE FESTIVAL

Big Crowd Hears Grade School Students Per- form Last Night

A crowd of nearly 2,000 persons thronged Central school lawn and adjacent ground early last evening for the spring festival of city grade schools, a remarkably pretty program enhanced by attractive costumes of participants.

Because of the poor location chosen for the presentation, the program was unfortunately robbed of much of its excellence due to the fact that many in the vast crowd were unable to see or hear the actors. Crowding of listeners into the small space reserved for the children taking part in the festival made it extremely difficult for the small, well trained school students to perform.

Music of miniature bands, pretty dances and charming choral numbers made up the well-balanced program. Work of the girls' glee club evoked much favorable comment. More than half the members of the boys' glee club, after weeks of training, failed to appear for the program last night, leaving the 15 faithful members to carry on as best they might.

The program, directed by Ruth A. Holloway, music supervisor in the schools since February, showed careful training on the part of teachers and reflected the co-operation of Miss Hill, of Mill; Mrs. Ellis of Fairview, Miss Grading and Mrs. J. P. Wells of Riverside, Miss Beatrice Phinney of Pelican, Miss Chandler of Fairview, Mrs. Hackett and Miss Olson of Central, and the accompanists, Miss Augusta Parker of Fremont, and Mrs. Don J. Zumwalt, well known local pianists.

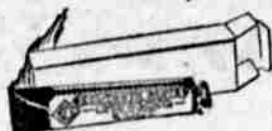

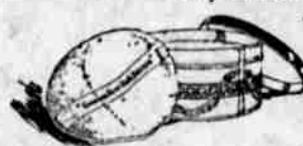

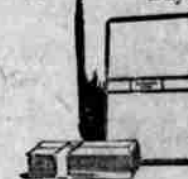
