

KAISER BILL AND CANTIGNY, TEN YEARS AFTER THE WAR

Ten years after the Yanks launched their first big attack by capturing Cantigny on May 28, 1918, and turned the tide of the war, Herr Wilhelm Hohenzollern, the former kaiser, continues to live in quiet seclusion at his estate near Doorn, Holland, as these recent and newest pictures of him show.

On the right is the former German emperor enjoying a quiet smoke after tea with friends on his vast and beautiful estate. The police dog's name is Harro, a pet of Princess Hermine.

At the left is the former ruler of the wood pile in a far corner of the spacious grounds. He keeps fit by daily sawing and chopping.

Below is Cantigny as it looked when the Americans entered the town 10 years ago, and a scene showing how the same spot looks today. The monument in the picture on the right stands on exactly the same spot as that occupied by the devastated farmhouse on the left. In this twisted timber ruin, the only structure still standing, Americans captured several German machine gunners.

Lone-Handed Globe Circling Trip Planned By War Aviator; Would Traverse 35,000 Miles

WASHINGTON, July 13. (UP)—G. H. Stork, a world war veteran, is preparing to make a lone-handed, aerial "pleasure flight" around the globe, it was learned today.

Stork has been proceeding quietly with his plans and has secured the cooperation of the navy and coast guard in establishing gasoline bases on the Aleutian Islands.

The U. S. S. Vega, navy destroyer, has been ordered to carry 200 gallons of gasoline and 10 gallons of lubricating oil to Unalaska, Alaska, for Stork's use. The coast guard cutter Unalga has been instructed to pick up 100 gallons of gasoline and five gallons of oil and cache them on Attu island, on the tip of the Aleutians.

According to information given Captain Chiswell, acting commandant of the coast guard, Stork is enroute to England to secure his plane, a single-seated Avro-Avron seaplane with a 60 horsepower engine, similar to the machine used by Bert Hinkler on his England-Australian flight.

Stork told Captain Chiswell he would fly from England to India in a series of short flights. From India, Stork said he would proceed across Asia to Japan. From Tokyo, Japan, his course would carry him to the Kamchatka peninsula of Siberia, to Attu

Island, to Unalaska, Juneau and down the Pacific coast to Seattle. After reaching Seattle, Stork said it was his intention to cross the continent and then fly back to England by way of Greenland and Iceland.

If the ambitious flyer completes his proposed trip, he will have covered approximately 35,000 miles.

Stork came here a few days ago. He avoided publicity and went quietly to the commerce department where he took and successfully passed the tests for a licensed pilot. In his commerce department papers he gave as previous experience in flying several years in France during the war. Stork said he was an American citizen born in Paris. He said in his papers that he had been living in Shanghai during the past few years.

TWO COUNTRIES PATCH QUARREL

SANTIAGO, Chile, July 13. (UP)—Chile has accepted Secretary Kellogg's proposal for a definite statement favoring renewal of diplomatic relations between Chile and Peru, it was officially announced tonight.

Secretary Kellogg intervened recently in an attempt to bring about resumption of relations after nearly 15 years of dispute over the provinces of Tacna and Arica.

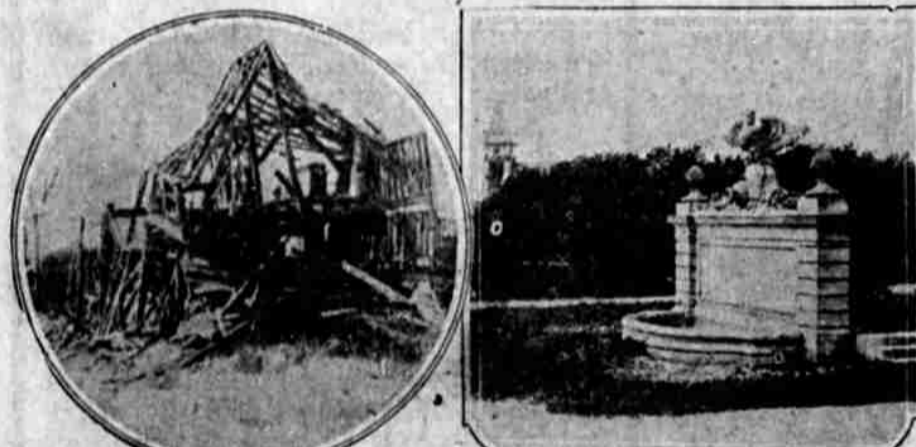
