NO MYSTERY PUNCH. The secret stroke which was given in confidence to Bill Tilden and his tennis band when they sailed for England and France to knock off the French Davis Cup holders must have been lost on the voyage. Or it didn't work.

Officials of the Lawn Tennis association professed to be profoundly impressed with the new stroke discovered by Dwight Douglas, a pro inventor, and it was rumored about that Tilden had been given the secret and it would be an effective as that new American gas the boys heard so much about during the last days of the war.

It was a fancy sounding story at its best, and according to late reports from Tilden it was a myth. Tilden told interviewers in London that he had never heard of the stroke or its inventor and that the idea was absurd.
