FRANCIS TRIMS DOWN FOR BIG FIGHT FRIDAY

Johnny Drops Sparring Partner for Count of Ten Last Night

Of course, it is impossible to forecast exactly. If that were possible, the game should lose its charm. But, if work-outs of the fighters are a criterion, or if the respective records of the main eventers are worth the paper they are written on, Friday night's fight between Francis and Kewpie Riley, should be a "natural."

The more probes into the main event, the more it appears that "One Round" Johnny Francis record of three straight one round knock-outs, is going to be upset.

Since that time Francis has been hoping for the chance to meet his old rival, inside the famous "squared circle."

Riley, Sammy Filby and Frankie Warnicke arrived today to get ready for their respective fights Friday night. They were accompanied by Sam Dorman, their manager.

Warnicke will meet Harry Johnson of San Francisco in the semi-windup.

"It's about time we see a few new faces in the ring," said Tex Bickertaff who is always casting about for a new angle. Both boys are in great shape.

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Last night Francis was working out with Husky Johnson, a 145 pound slugger. The little lightweight caught the bigger man flush on the chin with one of his famous rights and dropped him like a log for the count of ten.

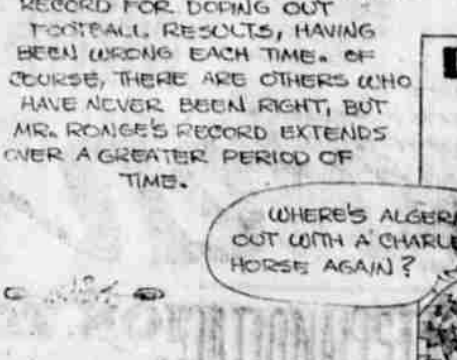

CORVALLIS, Ore., Oct. 24. (A. P.)—Preparing for the tilt with the University of Washington next Saturday at Seattle, the Oregon State college gridsters are making the most of scrimmage practice with the freshmen, while the second stringers are doing battle with the rooks.

HANS STEINKE BEATS M'GILL

Foul Ends Long-Drawn-Out Match in Tulsa, Oklahoma

TULSA, Okla., Oct. 24. (AP)—Hans Steinke won over Pat McGill last night on a foul in a long drawn out wrestling match which ended when McGill threw Steinke over the ropes.

Each man had won a fall previously but the referee awarded the match to Steinke.

Even though he lost the match, McGill when he pinned Steinke's bulky shoulders to the mat for the one fall, accomplished what no other wrestler in America has been able to do. It was the first fall Steinke had lost since coming to this country five years ago. McGill won his fall with a double wrist lock and head scissors in one hour and one minute while Steinke took the first fall in 35 minutes.

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Tribe of Jones Wins Honors in Several Sports

The Joneses and Smiths have contributed some of the greatest stars in every line of athletics. The name of Smith for many years exceeded all other names in athletics, but they now have reason for concern, for the name of Jones is becoming more popular.

Bobby Jones, the super golfer, has somewhat crowded the Alec MacDonald and Willie Smiths out of the golfing picture and in baseball no less than forty players have borne the distinguished name of Jones since 1882.

The first was Charles Jones back in 1883 who made two home runs in one inning with the old Boston Club.

"Jumping Jack" Jones of Yale was supposed to be the first collegian to break into professional baseball.

Mickey Jones of Hamilton, Canada, and Alex Jones of Homestead, Pa., were southpaws in the major league between 1887 and 1893.

Charles (Bumpus) Jones won fame for the name, pitching a no-hit, no-run game in his first effort in the major league, for Cincinnati against Pittsburgh in 1893.

Other famous baseball Jones were Fielder Jones of the Chicago White Sox; Tom and Davy Jones of the Detroit Tigers; Oscar Jones, the great Brooklyn pitcher from 1903 and 1907.

Then there is Bobby Jones, who played ten years at third base for Detroit and "Sad Sam" Jones, now with the St. Louis Browns, and Percy Jones of the Chicago Cubs.

Today, in the different minor leagues, south of the Mason and Dixon line, there were seventeen Joneses, and all were headed for the big show.

NATIONALISTA DEFEATS PINTO

Filipino Drops His Opponent Twice in First Round

PORTLAND, Ore., Oct. 24. (AP)—Young Nationalista, Filipino bantamweight, Los Angeles, scored two knockdowns over Charley Pinto, Buffalo, in the opening rounds of their 10-round main event here last night and held this advantage throughout to gain the decision. Pinto proved his staying qualities and came back strong, but the Filipino's early lead was too much to overcome.

Sam Warren, 172-pounder, of Portland, dropped Earl Beebo, 173, eight times, five in the second and three in the third; to win their battle on a technical knockout. Eddie Cartwright, negro, Portland, won a six round decision over Terry Kileen, Salem.

Bud Eads, Los Angeles, and Johnny Larose, Portland, went four rounds to a draw. Bobbie Vernon, soldier from Vancouver, knocked out Irvy Dunn, Albina, in the second round. Dunn went down for a count of nine in the first.

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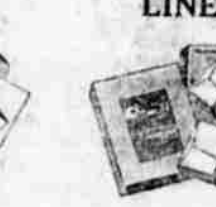
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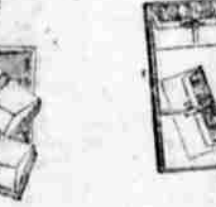
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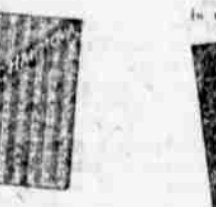
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
