

FOCH BELIEVES HE'LL RECOVER

**Famous General Will Not
Admit He Is Beaten
By Grim Reaper**

PARIS, Feb. 28. (AP)—While Marshal Foch is well prepared for death he still believes he will recover from his present devastating illness, friends say.

These friends have an intense admiration for the fortune with which the aged warrior has borne the suffering of his infirmity, the patience with which he has submitted to treatment, and without the keenness of his intellect.

But they do not share the marshal's hope. Every day now finds his strength reduced still more and makes more apparent that in view of his 78 years it is remarkable that he has resisted so long.

His life, one of his friends said, is a flame still burning steadily, but at the mercy of the least puff of wind. To shield it

from such a puff is the constant endeavor of the marshal's medical attendants, and his family. Among the marshal's visitors yesterday was Father J. Hande, famous Jesuit preacher, who came at the marshal's own request. The marshal insisted, however, there be no talk of extreme unction, the rite of the Roman Catholic church for the faithful who are in danger of death.

"He talked about Napoleon's campaign in Italy," said the priest.

The official bulletin this morning said: "The marshal's condition is stationary. His temperature is 99.3, pulse 86."

LOG CREWS ARE SENT TO WOODS

near future. The logs will be shipped not only to the Shaw-Bertram mill, south of Klamath Falls, but also to the former Wheeler-Olmstead mill, which Shaw-Bertram has leased from F. Hill Hunter for another year. The Shaw-Bertram mill is operating on a two-shift basis at shift. The plant employs between

present, while the box factory and planing mill are on one shift. However, it was explained, two shifts would be started at the box factory later in March.

The former Wheeler-Olmstead plant will resume operations, after shut-down for repairs, on March 15. One shift will be inaugurated at the start, but within a couple of weeks, when the output of the logging crew is 100 per cent, will be increased to two shifts. The Klamath Lumber and Box sawmill will resume operations March 11 with two shifts. The box factory has been operating throughout the winter on one shift. The plant employs between

200 and 250 under normal operating conditions. The mill is buying its logs.

The Big Lakes Box company, the only large mill in Klamath which has continued operating its log crew throughout the winter, will probably shut down for several weeks during March for repairs—but only long enough to make necessary improvements and maintenance work. The sawmill has operated two shifts throughout the winter, and has maintained its box factory on a one-shift basis throughout the season.

Lamm's mill at Modoc Point

will send its logging crew of about 125 men into the woods March 15. The sawmill, however, will shut down in the middle of the month for repairs of several weeks, and will resume operation as soon as possible. The mill has been operating steadily throughout the winter.

Both logging operations and the sawmill of the Forest Lumber company will resume March 15. About 125 men are employed in the woods, while the planing mill and sawmill will employ between 200 and 250 under normal operating conditions.

The Forest Lumber company

sawmill at Pine Ridge has been shut down since December 25—the first time the mill has been subjected to a thorough overhauling in three years. Logging operations will be carried on in a reservation unit 25 miles from the mill.

The planing mill has been running on a reduced basis throughout the winter. The sawmill will begin with one shift, but will increase to two shifts as soon as the logging crew gets established and produces logs on a normal output basis. At this time the Forest Lumber company has employed an extra crew to clear up the yards in preparation for the season's operation.

The Chiloquin Lumber company of Chiloquin has been operating its logging crew on its reservation unit eight miles from the plant, for two weeks, and its sawmill since the first part of February.

The Kesterson Lumber company of Dorris, Calif., starts its sawmill on a one-shift basis tomorrow morning and, within 30 days will increase it to two shifts. The logging crew will commence the first of April in Kesterson holdings contiguous to Dorris. About 125 men are employed in the woods and 100 men in the mill.
