Union Pacific Expenditures for Year Told

PORTLAND, Ore., March 8, (AP)—More than \$28,000,000 will be spent in Oregon, Washington and western Idaho by the Oregon-Washington railroad & Navigation company, northwest unit of the Union Pacific system, J. P. O'Brien, general manager, announced today. This is \$500,000 more than the road's 1928 expenditures.

The budget sets aside \$2,600,000 for improvements, including

\$725,000 for replacing rail with heavier material; \$238,000 for yard and passing track extensions and improvements; \$240,000 for widening cuts and embankments, and \$239,000 for improvements to shops and engine handling facilities.

An expenditure of \$24,000 will be made for elimination of grade crossings and improvements to signal systems.

New depot facilities and improvements to existing stations to the extent of \$106,000 are planned. New rolling stock and improvements to existing equipment will cost about \$102,000.

Based on 1928 operations, Mr. O'Brien estimates that about \$14,700,000 will be expended on wages and \$8,500,000 in material purchases.
