

LET CONTRACTS FOR 3 SCHOOLS

Contracts for the construction of additions to the schools at Chiloquin and Malin, a new school at Fort Klamath and for two teachers' cottages, one at Crescent and one in Poe Valley has been let by the county school board.

The board also called for bids to be opened June 3 for additions to the schools at Merrill, Bonanza, Keno and two additional teachers' cottages.

Contract for a three-room addition to the Malin school, including new plumbing was awarded to Karl D. Gentry for \$12,000.

Reinero and Harper with a bid of \$15,025 were successful bidders on a three-room brick

addition to the Chiloquin school. This also includes new plumbing fixtures for the school.

A new two-room brick veneer schoolhouse will be built at Fort Klamath under a contract let to J. J. Cunningham in the sum of \$11,853. A library, furnace room, and new plumbing fixtures are included in the contract.

Award Heating Job
N. Cherry was awarded the contract for constructing the teachers' cottages at Crescent, on a bid of \$1,200, and at Poe Valley for \$1,050.

William Lorenz and Hogaboom with a joint bid were awarded contracts for the installation of heating systems and the new Fort Klamath school on a total bid of \$12,000. Fan type furnaces will be installed in each place.

Successful Bids Low
All successful bidders tendered the lowest bids received for each job. Fred Peterson, county school superintendent stated.

June 3 the board will open bids for an auditorium-playshed addition with janitor's quarters and new plumbing at the Bonanza school; a one-room addition

and plumbing changes at the Keno school; and for two additional teachers' cottages.

All improvements and new schools are to be completed by school time next fall, under the terms of the contracts. The additions, changes and new schools are being built with money voted last February by the Klamath county district in a bond issue of \$750,000.
