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CUT-OFF DERBY TO BE OPENED EARLY IN JULY

Big Aviation Gathering Will Be Staged in Redding, California

ALTURA, Calif., June 19.—One of the largest aviation gatherings to be held in California this year will open the Yellowstone Cutoff air derby which will be held between Redding, Calif., and Boise, Idaho, on July 7 in the dedication of Benton airport at Redding.

Announcement has just been made by the committee in charge of this event of the various features of the day which will include the unveiling of the Benton memorial erected to the memory of Lt. John Benton for whom the field was named, formation flying and aerobics by the army, navy and marine corps flyers, races, parachute jumps, dead stick landings and many other feature events.

The future aviators have been given an interesting place on the program in participation for prizes offered for the best models of various types of planes.

At least five thousand people will gather at Redding from various points in northern California for this day and to witness the start of the Yellowstone air derby.

Officers of the Yellowstone Cutoff Airways association are receiving inquiries from many of the flyers of the coast states regarding entry of planes in the derby competition, and present appearances indicate that the entry list will be large when it is completed.

Invitations have been forwarded to many of the cities, airports and organizations in the west asking that official entries be placed in the event, and a selection of official representatives for cities and organizations is being made.
