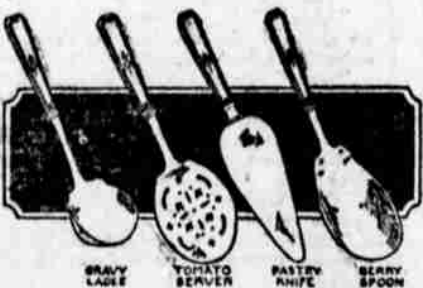
Eight-Day Normandie Chime Clocks
