

HALL PRAISES LOCAL AIRPORT

Seeley Hall, manager of the Medford airport, an aviation instructor in the army during the World War, and state chairman of aviation for the American Legion, yesterday addressed the weekly luncheon of the Lions club when Fred Flock acted as chairman.

Howard Graham received so much applause on his vocal numbers "Duna" and "When My Ship Comes Sailing Home," that he consented to sing "Can't You Hear Me Calling Caroline." He was accompanied at the piano in his first two numbers by Mrs. Rex Hyatt and in the last by Mrs. A. J. Voyer.

Hall in his talk stated that there are now 1,520 airports operated under the supervision of the department of commerce. He stated that there will be 1,200 more built this year. He said that what is needed is more airports, and not a few costing millions of dollars.

He told of the airlines now in operation on the coast and of the air routes being lighted by beacons every 150 miles. He also told of the radio stations being installed and the printer telegraph service. The radio will furnish weather reports for aviators at any time and will eliminate the weather hazard, which Hall said was the worst danger in flying now.

He said that Klamath had a wonderful site for its airport and predicted an eastern Oregon air route soon. He stated that "We on the other side of the mountain are willing to help in any way we can."

He stated that airports draw revenue from sales of gasoline and oil, a restaurant and storage of planes. Three times he stated there have been so many planes at the Medford port that they have not had room in their 110 by 100 foot hangar to accommodate them all.

LEGION HEARS SEELEY HALL

Seeley Hall, state chairman for aviation for the American Legion and manager of the Medford airport, spoke last night at the local Legion post on aviation and airports.

Perry O. DeLap, second vice commander of the Legion, announced that he would be a candidate for a legislative post and that he tendered his resignation in the Legion office to the post. He stated that he would not hold office in the Legion and still be a candidate for office.

The executive council of the Legion will select a successor at its meeting Monday night.

Ben Dorris of Eugene urged the post to get behind the Portland post in its efforts to secure the national convention in 1931.

Many citizens interested in aviation attended the meeting last night to hear Mr. Hall. The speaker told of some of the points to watch in the construction of the port and praised the Klamath Falls move to establish a port. He stated that the site selected was "very fine."

Hall also told of the recent developments in aviation and some of the safeguards that are being established.

Commander Leon Crawford called attention to the fact that the first meeting of the post in April will be Past Commanders' night.

Holiday Fete For City Is Suggested

Clyde Zerby, who for the past 12 years has successfully conducted Fourth of July and Western Nights celebrations in Arizona and other states, will be present at the meeting of the Elks lodge on Thursday evening to present plans for a suggested Fourth of July celebration here this year.

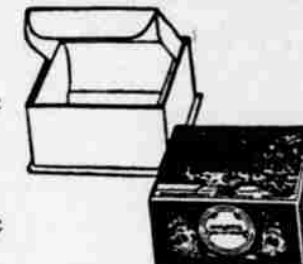
