## MARKET QUOTATIONS

**PORTLAND, June 3. (AP)—**Egg and butter prices continue unchanged with the undertone without strength. Egg values appear to be the stronger of the two, with the co-operatives holding the situation well in hand.

Reviewing the fruit and vegetable situation, the Portland bureau of the U. S. department of agriculture says:

"Although strawberry supplies were present in moderate volume, canners and barretters' requirements took most offerings, with resultant sharp price advances on the wholesale market. First early sales on the farmers' market were made at low as \$1.75 per crate, but retailers paid up to \$3.50, later in the day. It now appears that barretters will act as a decided stabilizing influence during the rest of the season, as their requirements are not nearly filled yet."

"Cantaloupes weakened about 25c per crate. Cants show very wide variation in quality, with price ranges of 75c per crate, for identical sizes."

"There is almost too much lettuce for the Portland market, but hardly enough to interest outside carlot buyers. Consequently, prices are low, although quality is generally excellent. Washington is now shipping as high as 60 cars daily, mostly from the Puget Sound district, with a few cars from Walla Walla."

"Portland has a few cars of mixed vegetables available for shipment, but competitive north districts are underselling Portland's prices, and getting the business now. In other words, Portland's own market is considerably higher than most points in the northwest, for most vegetables."

"Green peas will be available for carlot movement this week. SUTIAK (canned beans); Steady. Cane, fruit or berry, \$4.99 per cwt. Beet sugar, \$4.75 cwt.
