A large number of rooters from Sacramento are expected to arrive in a special train on July 4th to boost for their team which has made a good record in the region of Sacramento so far this season. July 6 the Pelicans will play the Lakeview team, starting at noon.

The Pelicans, managed by Red Sanders, lost to Medford in the playoff of a tie for first place in the Southern Oregon Baseball league's first half of the season. Klamath Battery Strong Steve Beck, Earl Hilton and "Big Boy" Mosier are Klamath's stellar battery of hurlers. Jimmy Mann, on call to the Hollywood coast league team, and Gunnar Peterson, former league player, are on the receiving end of the Klamath battery.

Walter Peterson is on first base. L. A. "Pop" Varnadore plays second; Walter Fuller covers the shortpatch and Bill Granger holds down the third sack.

Ziel Batting Threat Eddie Ziel, in right field, has the honor of being Klamath's batting threat; Richard Means is in the center patch and Bill Shipman plays in the left pasture.

The Klamath Pelicans are sponsored by the Elks lodge which purchased the uniforms and was instrumental in the organization of the league.
