

NEW DISCOVERY THROWS LIGHT ON EARLY LIFE

Skull Of Earliest Man Found in Region of Peiping, China

PEIPING, China, July 30. (A.P.)—Discovery of a second anthropoid skull was announced by Dr. Davidson Black of the Rockefeller Foundation at a meeting of the Chinese geological survey today.

The new specimen which was placed together from unscrupulous fragments was stated to have yielded valuable information concerning certain parts not represented in the first skull found last December.

Dr. Black said he believed the second skull was that of a young adult male whereas the previous find probably was that of a girl.

Brain Case Complete
Reports last December of the discovery of a new "Peking man" skull by a Chinese geologist working in the quarries near Peiping aroused much interest in scientific circles. At the time it was found it was described as the most complete discovery of its kind in history. The entire brain case was intact which is not the case in the Pildown man and other near-dawn discoveries.

Dr. Black, formerly of Toronto, describing the discovery of this first skull, recounted the excavations since 1921 when the first tooth was found of sinanthropus Pekinensis by Dr. J. G. Anderson, British scientist.

Million Years Old
Dr. Black also called attention to the vault of the skull form and the massive brow bridges. This skull was estimated to be more than 1,000,000 years old and to have shown a comparatively large brain capacity.

Vessels Collide In Dense Fog Off Gibraltar Coast

GIBRALTAR, July 31. (A.P.)—The British India Steamship company's steamer Nerubudda and the Spanish steamship Legazpi collided this morning in a dense fog 100 miles east of Gibraltar.

Wireless reports from the Nerubudda said she might be able to keep afloat, while the Legazpi said her engines were out of commission.

Salvage steamers rushed from Gibraltar to the disabled vessels. The Nerubudda is a vessel of 2653 tons, and the Legazpi of 2653 tons.

Officials of the British India Steam Navigation company, owners of the Nerubudda, said so far as they knew there were no passengers aboard the ship, though there might be one or two. The boat is a freighter from Australia for the continent and the United Kingdom.

The officials said they had been unable to obtain any details of the collision.
