FAMOUS INDIAN FIGHTER DIES IN CALIFORNIA

Colonel Arrasmith Led Long March Against Lapans in 1872

SAN LEANDRO, Cal., Aug. 5. (AP)—The death here of Colonel James M. Arrasmith, U. S. A., retired, famous Indian fighter and hero of two campaigns abroad, became known today.

Colonel Arrasmith was 74 years old and had lived here since his retirement 10 years ago. He died Saturday.

Arrasmith distinguished himself in an expedition on the Mexican border in 1872 in the Lapan Indian uprising. Degradations of the Lapan band had inflamed the border and General McKinney was sent to quell the disturbance. Arrasmith served as a lieutenant under McKinney.

The Lapan fought savagely but were subdued after Arrasmith led a march which covered 120 miles in 20 hours. The march became famous in American military annals. Arrasmith was one of the few men to come through the expedition without a scratch and thus earned the sobriquet "Lucky Jim."

During the Philippine insurrection Arrasmith distinguished himself by the way in which he bolstered the morale of his men, who had been losing their confidence in a bitter engagement. Arrasmith walked the entire length of the battle front, exposing himself to enemy fire to encourage his command.
