MARKET QUOTATIONS PORTLAND, Sept. 12. (AP)—Portland wholesale butter and egg markets remained unchanged Saturday in tone and price. Moderate volume of early day business was reported for each. Butter receipts continued greater than a week ago.

Highlights of the fruit and vegetable trade were given by the government market news service as follows: Potatoes are very firm, as the result of the recently released crop estimate figures, which showed a tentative reduction of \$3 million bushels in the nation's production. Sharp advances are entirely possible within the next few days. Yakima growers are refusing offers of \$30.00 per ton for No. 1a.

Dillard cantaloupes continue to realize a premium over competitive stock in eastern markets; but in most markets, there are still liberal supplies of home-grown cantaloupes. Local demand for head lettuce is improving, with light receipts of home-grown stock. Seattle is shipping considerable volume of lettuce, peas and cauliflower to Portland.
