

## FRONTIER OF RUSSIA SCENE OF BLOODSHED

LONDON, Nov. 14. (AP)—Fighting between peasants and communist forces, resulting in much bloodshed in the regions of Ostrov and Opotokha near the Lettish-Russian frontier was reported in Reuters dispatches from Riga today.

The population of a number of villages was reported in the Riga press to have revolted after attempts had been made to enforce the seizure of corn and collectivization of farms.

The villages of Jelino and Dubki were said to have been destroyed by bombardment from an armored train while other villages were damaged.

A number of peasants were reported executed and many families imprisoned.

EUGENE, Nov. 14. (AP)—The opening skirmish of the Oregon-Oregon State football conflict, rising to a climax in the variety encounter at Corvallis tomorrow, will be fought here tonight between the Oregon freshmen and the Oregon State rooks. The game will continue a twenty year feud, in which the frosh has won 10 games and the rooks seven, and three resulted in ties. Both teams are in playing condition.

## Army and Navy Adopt Plan For Benefit Game

WEST POINT, N. Y., Nov. 14. (AP)—The Army today agreed to meet the Navy in a charity football game in New York Dec. 13, for the benefit of the unemployed.

The army decision was announced by Major General William R. Smith, superintendent of the military academy, after a conference with his athletic council. It makes possible the first service game since 1927 when the army won 14 to 9 at the polo grounds.

The Dec. 13 date, proposed by navy yesterday after Dec. 6 and Nov. 29 had proved impracticable because of conflict with the Navy-Pennsylvania and Army-Notre Dame games, respectively, was accepted by the Army despite its conflict with mid-term examinations.

Because of the seriousness of the unemployment situation, General Smith said the Army was willing to make sacrifices to play the game.

## Singer Favored To Win Battle From Canzoneri

NEW YORK, Nov. 14. (AP)—Al Singer's first defense of his lightweight championship brings him up against rugged little Tony Canzoneri in Madison Square Garden tonight in a 15 round bout.

Singer, who won the title by knocking out Sammy Mandell in a single round here last summer, is a favorite at odds of 2 to 1 or more.

Singer campaigned in brilliant fashion through the summer but was knocked out in three rounds by Jimmy McLarin in an over-weight match in September.
