With approximately 75 per cent of the wool crop in the Klamath empire owned by borrowers from federal credit agencies, interest is strong here in the announcement that the government will require the 1934 clip to be handled on a consignment hasis as was the case last year.

The federal intermediate credit hanks, the production credit associations and the Regional Agricultural Credit corporation, have been notified to instruct all growers indebted to them that all their woel for the clip year 1934 shall be consigned to commission firms or dealers including the National Wool Marketing corporation or other wool cooperatives approved by the wool and mohair advisory committee of the Farm Credit Administration.

Such borrowers are also to be advised that none of the wool shall be sold at country points. No cash loans or advances shall be made to growers on consigned wool. Wool shall be consigned in the name of the grower and the particular unit of the farm credit administration involved.

The grower shall have the right to select the party to whom his wool or mohair shall be consigned from the approved list of the advisory committee. Such consigned wool or mohair will be sold in consuming markets in an orderly manner under a firm price-selling polley throughout the normal selling season. Houses receiving such wool will be required to dispose of it ratably with other stocks they have on hand, so the farm credit wool will participate in the consuming market equitably.

Wool or mohair consigned to houses under the foregoing provisions shall be sold with a commission charge of 2 cents per pound on original bag wool, and an additional one-half cent per pound for wool that requires grading, with free storage and insurance for four months plus a guarantee of sales accounts. After the four-month period, charges for storage and insurance shall be at the rate of 15 cents per bag per month. Freight and cartage for wool or mohair shall be charged for at actual cest with interest at 5 per cent on the amount involved.

Handling of governmentmortgaged wool in this manner last year was credited with strengthening the market and giving the growers a considerably improved price. About 25 per cent of the wool in the Klamath country is free fleece.

There was no verification bere wednesday of reports of large wool contracts either made or pending in this area.

Western States to Demand Share of Navy Building






