

FIRE PREVENTION ON 4-H PROGRAM

Fire prevention and elimination of fire hazards has been introduced into the regular work of 4-H club projects all over the

state, according to Frank Sexton, county club leader, who has received bulletins and instructions from the state fire marshal's office and H. C. Seymour, state club leader. The bulletins were prepared for 4-H study by the fire marshal and the extension service of Oregon State College. Listed in the bulletin are some of the most common fire hazards. These risks will be discussed by 4-H club boys and girls

and as many as possible eliminated around their homes and communities. At the close of the year each club member will prepare a report of work done, and dates of elimination of hazards. These reports will be judged and county winners, a boy and a girl selected. The reports will then be sent to the office of the state club leader and the fire marshal's committee will select the state winner, and prizes given for the best work. Boys and girls in any 4-H club project are eligible to enter the fire prevention work, the club leader asserted. The prizes will be: State winners, scholarship for 4-H club summer school for year 1934; county winners: gold medals, each club member completing the assigned work and filing a report, will receive a certificate of achievement in recognition of the work, signed by the state fire marshal. Sexton has been visiting various clubs in the county during the week introducing the fire prevention work.

Southern Pacific Will Install New Cooling Systems

Representing an expenditure of \$650,000 plans for air conditioning a part of the equipment carried by leading trains over its four well known routes were announced yesterday by the Southern Pacific Company. The improvement program was revealed here by L. L. Graham, district freight and passenger agent on receipt of a telegram from Felix S. McMillan, vice president in charge of passenger traffic. Although installation is being

made at great expense, there will be no extra fare for transportation in the air-conditioned cars, it was emphasized. Trains included in the present plans are the Cascade, Overland, Golden State, and Sunset, connecting California with the north, east, southwest and south, with San Francisco, Los Angeles, Portland, Chicago and New Orleans as their terminals. The new air-conditioned equipment will be ready about May 20, it was stated in time for the annual tourist season, and will give full protection against summer heat. Dining cars on the Overland, Golden State and Sunset have been air-conditioned, for some

time, but it is now the intention of Southern Pacific to install the same comfort-producing system in observation, lounge, club and Pullman room sleeping cars, according to the announcement.
