# National and Local Markets

## MARKET MOVES TO REGULATE EGG TRADING

PORTLAND, March 7. (AP)—The superiority of grades which has disturbed the egg market here for several weeks and has caused confusion and discouragement to producers, dealers and consumers alike, will be eliminated, effective today, if the Portland produce exchange can enforce its new trading provision, promulgated late Tuesday.

The exchange announced it had adopted government grades on eggs and that these grades alone will be used hereafter in trading.

The grades will be special, extra, standards and under-grades. Sizes will be designated by the terms "large," "medium," and "small."

The exchange pointed out that it will be necessary in selling to mark cases in accordance with the Oregon state law until such time as this law can be changed to comply with federal standards.

Market on butter continued its strong tone with an advance of 1c for cubes on the produce exchange, with the exception of firsts which were up 1/2 lb. Butterfat buying price advanced 1 pound.
