

## REPORTS OF THREE COUNTIES AWAITED

**SALEM, April 30, (AP)—**Registration reports from Lane, Jackson and Grant counties will be telegraphed for today by the secretary of state's office in an effort to close the registration books for the May 15 primary election within the next two days. David O'Hara, election clerk announced. All reports from the 32 other counties have been received.

Today's mail brought in the following from Baker, Crook and Umatilla counties, all of which are showing increases in both republican and democratic lists as well as in totals over the 1933 registration. Baker county went democratic, only county in the state which ranked more democratic than republicans.

Baker county reported 3,910 republicans, 4,248 democrats and 81 miscellaneous for a total of 8,239 voters. In 1933 it reported 3,290 republicans, 3,906 democrats and a total of 7,342.

Umatilla county sent in records of 7,811 republicans, 4,038 democrats and 142 miscellaneous for a total of 11,991. Last year it had 7,647 republicans, 3,906 democrats and a total of 11,553.

Crook county reported 1,244 republicans, 1,117 democrats and 30 miscellaneous for a total of 2,411. Last year it listed 1,263 republicans, 1,190 democrats and

## WAR DEPARTMENT ACCEPTS CHANGES

WASHINGTON, April 30, (AP)—The war department approved today applications by the Oregon state highway commission to make modifications in two bridges now under construction in Oregon.

Changes in the bridge to be constructed across Coon Bay near North Bend call for a horizontal clearance of 515 feet between fenders, instead of a horizontal clearance of 715 feet between piers.

On a bridge to be constructed across Yaquina Bay, near Newport, the horizontal clearance will be 395 feet between fenders, instead of 550 feet between piers.

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
