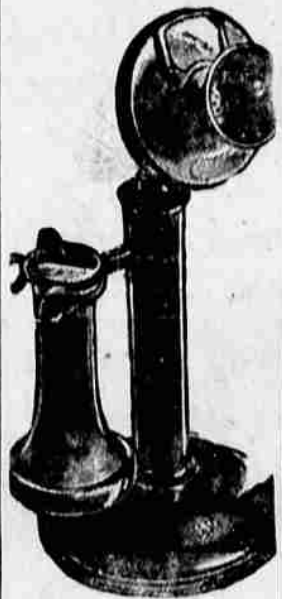

BOSTON WOOL

BOSTON, June 6 (AP) (U. S. Dept. Agr.)—Only scattered sales are being closed on domestic wools and transactions involve rather small quantities in most cases. The bulk of the trade is on fleeces, and a little graded light shrinkage strictly combing.

56 1/2 blood New York fleece wool has been sold at 33 cents in the grease. Graded shrinkage 48-50 1/2 blood wool from New York also has been sold at 31 cents in the grease. Country

wool sold for bulk 1/2 and 3/4 blood combing wools from the same state has brought 31 cents in the grease, delivered east.
