

KNIGHTS WILL PARADE HERE ON JULY 7TH

The famous band of Oregon commandery, No. 1, Knights Templar, will parade and drill in Klamath Falls on the evening of July 7, during a two-hour stop-over here on its way to the grand encampment of Knights Templar of the United States at San Francisco.

Accompanying the band will be the drill team, composed of 50 members from Portland, Eugene, Salem and other Oregon cities, and a large number of members of the organization.

According to plans announced by George P. Taylor, commander of Calvary Commandery, No. 16, of Klamath Falls, the band, drill team and knights in uniform will march from the depot to the courthouse, and stage a parade and drill on Main street between Third and Fourth streets.

This will be the only stop between Portland and San Francisco for the purpose of a demonstration of this sort, according to Taylor. The train will get in here at 7 o'clock, and the drill will probably be concluded about 8 o'clock.

Taylor has written a letter to Mayor W. E. Mahoney and the city council asking that Main street be roped off on the night of the drill.

Accompanying the band and drill team will be officers of the

grand commandery of Oregon. Taylor said that a number of special trains will pass through Klamath Falls both before and after the San Francisco convention.
