Ten Years Ago In Klamath

All of the property and holdings of the California Oregon Power company were this week transferred to the H. M. Byllesby company of Chicago, according to a well-founded report received here today from San Francisco. It has been known for some time that the Chicago concern has been negotiating for the purchase of the power company, and that a price of approximately \$20,000,000 had been set.
 Guns, traps and poison from four different counties will be turned over to the coyote bands of southern Oregon and northern California this winter and next spring. Depredations from these animals have caused great loss to livestock operators.

There should be a full understanding by the public that the official bulletins of the county health officer tell the whole story of the current epidemic of infantile paralysis in Klamath county. There are NO MORE and NO FEWER diagnosed cases of the disease than listed by the health officer, who receives reports from all physicians.
 Whenever a "scare" of this kind develops a lot of false rumors are started. Several inquiries have been received at this newspaper office indicating the kind of wild stories that go the rounds. Every citizen should refrain from helping spread these false rumors by informing himself definitely just what the situation is before he talks about it.
 At the time this is written there are six active cases in the county, all confined definitely to the Keno district. THERE ARE NO ACTIVE CASES IN KLAMATH FALLS.
 If any more cases develop, that fact will be announced from the health office. The general laws of Oregon require that all physicians, and any other person treating diseases, report any and all infectious cases to the county health officer, where the records are open for public inspection. The adopted policy is to keep

the public fully informed. It is a wise one. Every person can be fully informed if he will take his information from authentic sources, and if he will refuse either to believe or help spread unfounded rumors.
