AN ORDINANCE granting to

The Pacific Telephone and Tele-

graph Company, its successors

and assigns, the right and priv-

ilege to do a general telephone

and telegraph business and to

place, erect, lay, maintain and

operate in, upon, and under the

streets, alleys, avenues, thorough-

fares and public highways within

the City of Klamath Falls, poles,

wires and other appliances, and

conductors for the transmission

of electricity for telephone, tele-

graph and allied purposes of com-

munication, and repairing Ord-

inance No. 2217, heretofore passed

by the Mayor thereof in so far

as the same is applicable to

the grantee.

THE CITY OF KLAMATH

FALLS ORDAINS AS FOL-

LOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby

granted by the City of Klamath

Falls to The Pacific Telephone

and Telegraph Company, its suc-

cessors and assigns, the right

and privilege to do a general

telephone and telegraph business

within said City of Klamath

Falls and to place, erect, lay,

maintain and operate in, upon

and under the streets, alleys,

avenues, thoroughfares and pub-

lic highways within the said City,

poles, wires and other appliances
