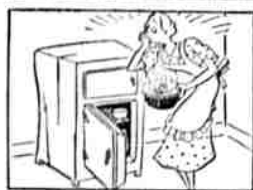
A chorus of 35 voices, with Joe Stafford as vocal soloist.
