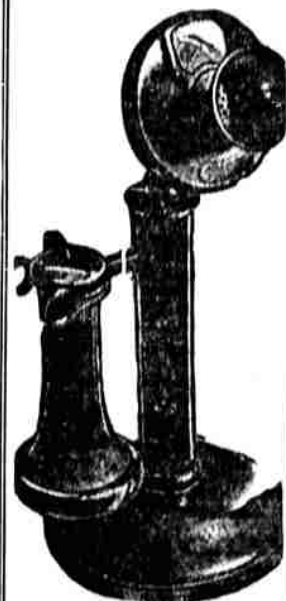

NEW YORK, Dec. 30. (A)—

Buying prices got behind the stock market today, and pushed prices up one to two or more points.

Although trading was not especially active, virtually all sections of the list participated in the forward move. The close was firm. Transfers approximated 1,550,000 shares.

Prominent in the climb were the steels which ignored official estimates of a decline in this week's mill operations. It was recognized the drop in output was a customary happening at the end of the year.

The oils exhibited strength, reflecting the growing use of petroleum products and the better statistical position of the industry.

Aircrafts were again in demand on expectations of more military building. The rails, utilities, rubbers, tobaccos, motors and specialties were popular.

Among the livelier share gainers were Douglas Aircraft, Wright Aeronautical, Curtiss Wright "A", United Aircraft, Standard Oils of New Jersey and California, Seaboard Oil, Liggett & Myers "B", American Tobacco "B", Chrysler, General Motors, U. S. Steel, Bethlehem, Crucible steel, American Can, American Telephone, Western Union, Goodyear, U. S. Rubber preferred, Mac. Truck, Santa Fe, New York Central, Delaware & Hudson, Woolworth, Westinghouse and Evans' Products.
