PORTLAND BUTTER ADVANCE QUOTED

PORTLAND, Feb. 13. (UP)—The advance of ½¢ lb. on standard and prime first butter during the holiday season to the produce exchange failed to develop any change in butterfat quotations.
The "set" price on butterfat here is 37¢ lb. but some interests are paying to 38½¢ lb. One cent was added to practically all egg prices except large extras.
With eggs higher and a lack of desire on the part of poultry men to cull their flocks, a further shortage of Leghorns was showing with premiums again promised for late week delivery.

CHICAGO, Feb. 13. (UP)—(U. S. Dept. Agr.)—Hogs 18,000; active, 15-25 higher than Wednesday's average; top 10.50; bulk desirable 10-24.90 lbs., 10.75-90; 25-30 lbs., largely 10.60-75; better grade 14-16 lbs., 10.50-85; good sows 9.50-10.00.
Cattle 8,000; calves 1,000; fed steers and yearlings steady to strong with better grade weights kinds slightly higher to shippers on a forced market due to storm; basic undertone trade weak because of continued sluggish demand for beef market; all low priced cattle getting good action; best fed steers 11.00; bulk 7.50-9.50; stocker and feeder trade at standstill; very active market on weighty sausage bulls at 7.25.

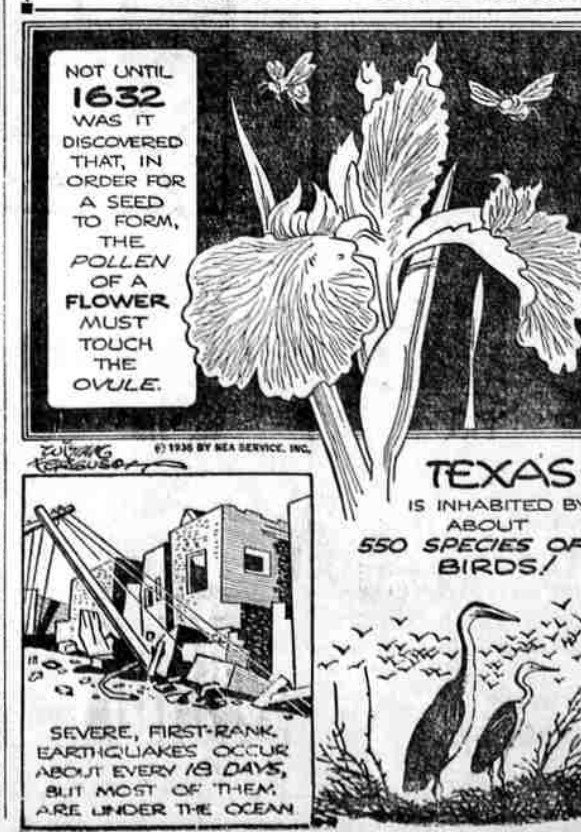
BOSTON WOOL
BOSTON, Feb. 13. (UP)—(U. S. Dept. Agr.)—Very few transactions were closed on domestic wools in Boston. Prices were firm on the scattered sales of limited volume. Average to good French combing 64s and finer territory wools were sold in original bales at 90-91 cents scoured basis. Fall Texas wools were moved at 74-77 cents scoured basis. Grease basis quotations were unchanged from last week on Ohio and similar fleece wools, but they were largely nominal in view of the limited volume of sales.
