

SCHOOL BUDGET WILL BE MADE NEXT MONTH

Budget for School District Number One will be made up in April this year instead of in October as has been customary, according to an announcement made following the regular meeting of the board of directors held Wednesday evening in Fremont school.

The change has been made to allow the budget committee to meet and include a item for re-wiring Riverside school, fireproof the furnace room and install an electric conduit, as recommended by Fire Chief Keith K. Ambrose last winter. No budget allowance had been made to cover these repairs, so they could not be done until after the new budget is made up.
