Legal Notices

State of Oregon, County of Klamath—ss.
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that Oregon Code, 1930, Section 26-2609, provides as follows:

26-2609: Duty to destroy ground squirrels and noxious rodents. It shall be and is hereby declared to be the duty of every person, firm, copartnership, company and corporation owning, leasing, occupying, possessing or having charge of or dominion over any land, place, building, structure, wharf, pier, or dock which is infested with ground squirrels and other noxious rodents or predatory animals, or as soon as the presence of the same shall come to his, their or its knowledge, at once proceed and continue in good faith to exterminate and destroy such rodents by poisoning, trapping or other appropriate and effective means. (L. 1919, c. 127; 1)

WITNESSETH: Every person, firm, copartnership, company or corporation owning, leasing, occupying, possessing or having charge of or dominion over any land, place, building, structure, wharf, pier, or dock, in Klamath county, State of Oregon, which is infested with ground squirrels, pocket gophers or other noxious rodents, shall, within 30 days from the date of the first publication hereof, begin, in good faith, to exterminate or eradicate such ground squirrels, pocket gophers, or other noxious rodents.

That poisoned oats prepared under the U. S. formula for the extermination of ground squirrels, may be procured from the office of the County Agent, Room 213, Federal Building, Klamath Falls; from Ben Faus, Merrill; Mac's Store, Mt. Laki; Kalina Store, Malin; Beebe Store, Bonanza; D. J. Bliss, Dairy; Hillbrand Store, Hillbrand; Langell Valley Irrigation District Office; Haskins Meat Market, Bly.

That the method of distributing such poison shall be as follows, to-wit: Place teaspoonful of poisoned oats at or near the mouth of the burrow in warm, sunny days, preferably in the morning. Cover the entire field or fields in this manner.

This notice is published, according to law, in two newspapers of general circulation in Klamath county, Oregon, for a period of 2 weeks, with 3 publications, to-wit:

Evening Herald, March 21, 28, April 2nd; Klamath News, March 22, 29 and April 3rd, the first publication being March 21st, 1936.

B. W. Short, G. J. Hillyard, I. J. Dixon, constituting the board of directors of Enterprise Irrigation District, for a judicial examination and judgment of the aforesaid petition as to the regularity and legality of the proceedings of the board of directors of said district in adopting a resolution authorizing and directing the issuance and sale of bonds of said district in the sum of Thirty-two thousand, five hundred dollars (\$32,500.00) and the terms and maturities thereof for the purpose of refunding present outstanding indebtedness of said district, and for the further purpose of a judicial examination and judgment of said court as to the regularity and legality of the proceedings of said board in authorizing the execution for and on behalf of said district of a contract with Reconstruction Finance Corporation for the sale to said corporation and the purchase by it of all or a part of the aforesaid bonds, and a judicial examination and judgment of said court as to the legality of such bonds and said contract aforesaid, and further, for a judicial examination and judgment of said court as to the right and duty of said irrigation district to levy each year until said bonds have been paid in full the necessary assessments provided for by said bond resolution and contract for the purpose of paying the principal and interest of said bonds.

TO: Enterprise Irrigation District of Klamath County, Oregon, and to all free-holders, legal voters and assessment payers within said district:

IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF OREGON, you are hereby notified that B. W. Short, G. J. Hillyard and I. J. Dixon, constituting the board of directors of Enterprise Irrigation District, a municipal corporation and irrigation district within Klamath County, Oregon, have filed in the above-entitled court a special proceeding for the purpose of having a judicial examination and judgment of said court declaring and decreeing that Enterprise Irrigation District is an irrigation district duly organized, acting and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oregon.

That B. W. Short, G. J. Hillyard and I. J. Dixon now are and during all times herein mentioned, were all of them duly elected, qualified and acting directors of said district, and that they together constitute the board of directors thereof, and that during all said time B. W. Short has been and is the president of said district, and that I. J. Dixon is the secretary of said district.

That the contract set forth in Exhibit "A" to said petition is a lawful contract on the part of Enterprise Irrigation District, and that all matters and things connected therewith and all proceedings of said board of directors and district with relation thereto have been duly and regularly held and had in the manner and as provided by law, and that the execution of said contract on the part of said district has been regularly and legally authorized.

That all of the proceedings of the board of directors of said district authorizing and directing the issuance of refunding bonds of said district in the amount of \$32,500.00 for the purpose of refunding present outstanding indebtedness of said district in the form and as set forth in the resolution Exhibit "C" to said petition, and said contract set forth in Exhibit "A", and all matters and things connected therewith, and all of the proceedings of the board of directors of said district with relation thereto, have been duly and regularly held and had in the manner and as provided by law, and as provided by law, and said bonds with and tenor therein set forth are regularly and legally authorized, and when executed and issued by said district and delivered to said Reconstruction Finance Corporation as provided in said contract, will be the legal and valid obligations of said Enterprise Irrigation District without any advertisement or public sale thereof.
