You may want sauce for the goose, or sauce for the gander, or sauce for the pudding, or sauce for the cake. A meat or dessert may lack completeness if it does not have just the right sauce over it. Often the "stand by" may be offered to the family under a new kind of sauce.
Our suggestions this week may prove very useful to you.

Pineapple Hard Sauce
Cream 1 1/2 tablespoons butter and 6 tablespoons powdered sugar. Chop 2 red cherries and mix with 1 tablespoon fully-drained crushed pineapple. Mix thoroughly and shape into a roll.

Roll in 2 walnuts chopped up fine. Make the roll about 1 inch in diameter. Slice and serve with puddings.

Melba Sauce
1 cup canned raspberries
1/2 cup sugar
Put raspberries through a sieve, add sugar and boil 5 minutes. Cool and keep in refrigerator until needed. Serve cold.

Cheese Sauce
3 tablespoons butter
3 tablespoons flour
1 cup milk
2 teaspoons prepared mustard.

1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce.
1 teaspoon salt
1 cup American cheese
Melt butter in top of double boiler. Add flour and blend well. Add milk slowly, stirring constantly, and cook over hot water until thick and smooth. Add the mustard and Worcestershire sauce and salt and cook 15 minutes. Add cheese, cut in small pieces, and stir until cheese is melted. Remove from heat. Makes 1 1/2 cups sauce.

Pineapple-Orange Sauce
Serve on baked ham.
2 tablespoons cornstarch
1/2 cup sugar
Few grains salt
1 cup orange juice
1 cup pineapple juice
2 tablespoons lemon juice
1 cup grated pineapple.
Mix cornstarch, sugar, and salt in top of double boiler; add orange, pineapple, and lemon juice. Cook over boiling water about 10 minutes or until trans-

parent, stirring occasionally. Add grated pineapple. Cook 2 minutes longer. Serves 12 to 16.

All Purpose Mexican Sauce
Here is indeed magic with which to work miracles in all manner of cookery. Chops, roasts, steaks, meat balls, loaves, etc., a gravy in which to reheat all manner of left-over meats, a juice, laden with flavor, to pour over rice, spaghetti, noodles, etc. Make it in quantities. Keep it in the ice-box. Its uses are myriad.

2 tablespoons butter
1 small onion chopped
1 clove of garlic, chopped
2 tablespoons flour
1/2 teaspoon salt
2 teaspoons chili powder
1 1/2 cups meat stock
1 cup tomatoes.
Cook onion, pepper and garlic slowly in the butter until soft, stirring often. Add flour, salt, and chili powder and stir until smooth. Add meat stock and

tomatoes. Cook until thick and smooth. Strain if desired.

Mint Sauce (For Meats)
8 stalks mint
2 tablespoons dry mint
2 tablespoons sugar
1 cup vinegar
1 tablespoon lemon juice.
Wash mint and pick leaves from stems. Chop fine, add sugar and rub well together. Add gradually vinegar and lemon juice. Let stand one hour.

3 in 1 Sauce
3 cups grated raw carrots
1 teaspoon grated onion
3 tablespoons butter
1/2 cup chicken or meat broth
1 cup condensed or top milk
1 pint tomato, chopped
4 ripe olives, chopped
Put carrot and onion in sauce pan with butter. Cook until brown, stirring frequently. Add flour and when smooth, add broth and cayenne. Stir until

sauce boils. Add milk, pimiento and olives. Serve hot. Meat stock may be made by dissolving 1 bouillon cube in 1 cup boiling water. Very good served over meat, fish loaf, or braised steaks. Can also be served over your favorite cooked vegetable.
