## Flaming Airliner Brought to Port, 3 Aboard Escape

CHICAGO, May 27, (U.P.)—An American Airlines plane which had just taken off for Detroit returned and landed in flames at the municipal airport Tuesday, but the pilot and two passengers escaped with slight injury.

Pilot Ed Coates noticed smoke issuing from the Michigan flyer's baggage compartment at 500 feet.

"I'm on fire and will make a quick landing," he radioed the airport control tower.

The control tower had just ordered a Chicago & Southern Airlines plane to land. The order was reversed and the southern liner circled the field.

Coates turned to his passengers.

"The ship's on fire," he said. "It will spread fast. Be ready to jump out as soon as my speed slackens on the runway."

His passengers, R. A. Alpaio, Detroit salesman, and W. C. Carnegie, a company employee, stood at the plane's door.

Coates came down fast, smoke and flame billowing from the plane. The fire was spreading quickly, fanned by the ship's speed.

The pilot brought the ship down in a perfect landing. As the plane slowed down on the runway Alpaio and Carnegie leaped. Coates brought the plane to a halt and followed them, but not before his hands were burned. The ship was destroyed by flames.

## Court Rule Gives Road Commission Control in Cities

SALEM, May 27, (U.P.)—State highway commission attorneys Tuesday interpreted a supreme court decision referring only to the city of Portland as giving the commission virtually unlimited power to build roads within the limits of all Oregon cities.

Expenditure of millions of dollars was authorized, in effect, by the ruling.

The supreme court's ruling gave the commission the right to build roads within Portland city limits, together with all the right implies—acquiring rights of way, widening streets or building roads where none exist, maintenance of the routes, by expenditure of state highway funds.

No distinction as made between primary and secondary highways. Specifically the suit involved right of the highway commission to extend the Oregon City super-highway. The commission brought a friendly suit against the city of Portland, but the Rose Island Band & Gravel Co., whose property the route would traverse, appealed.

## Famed Pioneer's Descendant Dies

CANBY, Calif.—Mrs. Ida May Caldwell of Canby, who died at the Modoc General hospital in Alturas Sunday after a long illness, was a third cousin of the late William Jennings Bryan and a direct descendant of Daniel Boone, relatives said.

Born in Vacaville in 1860, she was a charter member of the Native Daughters of the Golden West and later deputy grand president of the order.

She is survived by her husband, Henry Caldwell of Canby, where they resided for the past 37 years; a daughter, Mrs. J. B. Steele of Adin, and a twin brother, J. W. Lammie of Winters, Calif. Funeral services will be held in the Adin church Tuesday.

## Seasonal Workers Gain WPA Favor

PORTLAND, May 27, (U.P.)—Relief workers who leave WPA to accept seasonal, private employment will be given preferred status when they return, Administrator E. J. Griffith said Tuesday.

Griffith said WPA workers are being encouraged to accept private employment during the harvesting season and assured that their eligibility to receive relief when it is needed again will not be endangered.
