

MERRILL MAN TO ATTEND CONCLAVE

Harold Hendrickson, teacher in Merrill, was elected a delegate to the International convention in Detroit next August to represent the Catholic Order of Foresters for Oregon. This convention is held only once every three years, and only two delegates will attend from Oregon, the other being John Decher, state chief ranger, of Portland.

The state convention was held in Stayton, Oregon, last Saturday and Sunday, and Hendrickson attended as a delegate from "the famous Irish court of Merrill," as this local unit is designated. When the Holy Cross court was instituted in Merrill in 1934, it increased the membership in the Catholic

Order of Foresters in Oregon sufficiently to give them an extra delegate to the International convention, so the Merrill court will furnish the extra delegate this year.

Bishop to Preside at Church Function

Sunday the Most Rev. Bishop of the diocese of Baker City will administer the sacrament of confirmation to a large class of children and converts in the local Catholic church after the 9:30 mass.

Soon thereafter he erected the first Catholic church in Klamath county, which was torn down in 1929 to make room for the present building on the corner of High and North Eighth streets.
