

FARMERS FIGHT HIGH WATERS ON COLUMBIA

ASTORIA, Ore., June 19. (AP)—A 4,400-foot dike will be the answer of Brownsmead farmers to the Columbia river's threat to inundate hundreds of acres of valuable land.

A dike 10 feet high will be constructed inside the old protection which crumbled under heavy pressure the past few days. The county court approved a loan of \$5,000 to the dike district and offered to allow the county engineer to assist in the work. Appeals for aid also have gone to Senator Charles L. McNary (R-Ore.) and Governor Charles Martin.

Action to abandon the old dike—except insofar as it might be useful in protecting the new one—came after another 75-foot strip washed out as repairs to a smaller break were being completed.

Several hundred acres of land already are under water. Crops on three farms are believed a total loss. A small road dike was reinforced with sandbags to protect other valuable acreage.

SALEM, June 19. (AP)—Senator Charles L. McNary today advised the governor to contact Colonel T. M. Robins, U. S. army engineer at Portland, relative to flood relief in the lower Columbia valley due to dike breaks in Clatsop county yesterday.

McNary wired that the flood control bill, containing his amendments for Oregon, "has been on the president's desk for several days but he has taken no action thereon. I expect action today. If the bill is signed, I suggest you confer immediately with Colonel Robins and I shall ask for assistance here."

The governor yesterday wired McNary urging federal assistance after the Brownsmead dikes gave way.

PINE BUSINESS REPORTED ACTIVE

PORTLAND, June 19. (AP)—New business in the pine industry increased 9 per cent over last week, the report on 108 mills of the Western Pine association showed today.

Since January 1st, orders increased 13 per cent over the same period of 1935. Orders totaled \$5,393,000 board feet this week, compared to \$2,548,000 last week, and \$9,402,000 for the same week of 1935.

Shipments declined from 62,506,000 feet last week to 60,595,000 feet this week, although they were above the 58,233,000 mark for the same week of 1935. Production totaled 75,872,000 feet, against 75,399,000 feet last week and 70,380,000 feet a year ago.
