### REDUCED INTEREST WILL BE EXPECTED

Temporarily reduced interest on land bank loans will continue for one more year at 3 1/2 per cent to all members of national farm loan associations, President E. M. Ehrhardt of the bank at Spokane was informed today by Land Bank Commissioner A. S. Goss of Washington, D. C.

Commissioner Goss explained that President Roosevelt signed a bill June 25 extending the temporary 3 1/2 per cent rate until June 30, 1937, on all loans which have been made through and guaranteed by national farm loan associations. Borrowers who have obtained loans direct from the bank will pay a reduced rate of 4 per cent until June 30, 1937.

"Continuation of the 3 1/2 per cent rate for another year to national farm loan association members takes the place of the 4 per cent rate that would have prevailed for the coming year and the succeeding year and, Commissioner Goss wired President Ehrhardt, 'Under the law as now amended land bank borrowers on July 1, 1937, will resume interest payment at the rates at which their loans were originally written.'

"Farmers who obtain loans now at the prevailing 4 per cent contract rate will also get the benefit of the 3 1/2 per cent tempo-

very reduction for all interest in-  
staffments payable in the one-  
year period ending June 30, 1937,  
but after that date will pay 4  
per cent for the entire duration  
of their loans."

The temporary interest reduction applies on approximately \$2,000,000,000 of loans which have been closed through national farm loan associations during the nearly 20 years the land bank system has been in operation. It effects a substantial saving for nearly 40,000 north-west farmers who have financed their mortgages cooperatively through the land bank at Spokane.

Agricultural activities for the last 20 years have helped rather than hindered grasshoppers in the Great Plains area, according to Dr. J. R. Parker of the United States department of agriculture. In Montana, where hopper damage from 1930 to 1934 was estimated at more than \$17,000,000, cultivation of land originally in native grass has increased their egg-laying grounds and food supply. Bar patches of fairly compact ground appeal most to egg-laying grasshoppers. The patches must be near plenty of vegeta-

tion that will be green and succulent for the young hoppers. Before the soil on Montana ranges was disturbed, such conditions could be counted on only in river bottoms, and on sunny slopes of uplands in the plains and foothills east of the main range of the Rockies and between the Canadian border and the Yellowstone river. Now they are common on about 5,000,000 acres of nonirrigated grain crops and on thousands of miles of roadside, railway right-of-way, fence rows, and ditch banks, as well as in the old locations.

Formerly, continued drought dried up vegetation over a wide area, starved grasshoppers and checked heavy infestations. Today, even in extremely dry years, hoppers find enough to eat without going very far from their hatching grounds. The effectiveness of other natural checks—fungal and bacterial diseases that kept down the grasshoppers when they were confined to the flood plains of rivers and along small streams—has been reduced by man's agricultural activities. Hoppers are now able to spread from low, moist land where in rainy weather disease is rife—to higher land too dry for disease which they were unable to inhabit before the planting of corn, small grains, flax, alfalfa, and sweet-clover.
