Nine Murdered as Terrorism Flares Anew in Palestine

JERUSALEM, July 27. (UP)—Seven terrorist killings within 24 hours confirmed by the authorities Saturday brought violence in Palestine to a new height since the outbreak three months ago of guerrilla warfare waged by Arabs protesting Jewish immigration.

Renewed seriousness of the situation, recently brought under control with arrival of British military reinforcements from Malta and Egypt, was emphasized by fresh outbreaks throughout the country.

Seven shootings caused the seven officially known deaths and an undetermined number of wounded. Wholesale attacks on Jewish farm settlements caused grave apprehension here.

Moving to cope with the situation the police and military made wholesale arrests at several points. All persons possessing arms or explosives were ordered taken into custody.
