## Truck Drivers' Strike Closed

PORTLAND, Ore., Aug. 10 (UP)—The month old strike of city sand and gravel truck drivers, which had tied up building construction industry, ended peacefully Saturday.

The truck drivers will return to work Monday under union conditions.

Under the agreement signed by union officials and employers, the latter will pay the drivers overtime for any time after eight hours. Previously the producers had insisted on overtime only after nine hours, which had blocked negotiations.

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
