PEONAGE LAWS HELD VIOLATED

WASHINGTON, Aug. 13 (AP)—Attorney General Cummings today acted to send to a Little Rock, Ark., grand jury a report which he said contained evidence of possible violation of federal peonage laws by southern planters...

The report, prepared by Samuel E. Whitaker, a special assistant to Cummings, contained "conflicting" evidence, the attorney general said. He declined to explain use of the word "conflicting," but said there was a question as to what federal laws were involved...

Whitaker's investigation, Cummings added, failed to produce any evidence that a federal statute had been violated in connection with the alleged flogging of Miss Willie Sue Hagedorn, Memphis, Tenn., social worker, and the Rev. Claude C. Williams of Little Rock, near Keno, Ark., last June 12...

Val Lorwin, chairman of the committee to aid agriculture workers, struck a different note. "The thing we want to see the most," he said, "is a full and unbiased investigation. We are not satisfied that such an investigation has been made."

SALEM, Ore., Aug. 13 (Special)—Frank Tyrer, representing the Fidelity Mutual association and the Consolidated Insurance Underwriters, two unlicensed insurance organizations, both of Minneapolis, Minnesota, was tried in Clatsop county and fined \$50 and costs, and sentenced to 30 days in jail...
