Milk, Egg Production Up

INCREASE SHOWN IN USDA REPORT

PORTLAND, Ore., Aug. 18 (AP)—The U. S. department of agriculture said today milk and egg production in Oregon as of August 1 was higher on an average than on a corresponding date in either of the two preceding years.

The average was computed from the production of milk per cow and the number of eggs laid per 100 hens and pullets. On August 1, 1934, milk production was 16.8 pounds per cow, in 1935, 17.5 pounds, and this year 18.7 pounds.

The egg production as of August 1, 1934 was 47 per 100 hens and pullets, 47.9 in 1935, and 49.4 in 1936.

None of the five districts into which the state was divided for the survey showed a consistent increase in the two categories since 1934; but district 1, composed of the Willamette valley and northwestern Oregon, showed milk production above 1934 and 1935 and egg production above 1934 and equal to 1935.

Other districts varied but the increases over-balanced the decreases sufficient to give the state-at-large a general and consistent gain both in milk per cow average and in egg per hen and pullet average.

The report by districts, with the 1934, 1935 and 1936 production listed in that order, includes:

District 8 (Crook, Deschutes, Grant, Harney, Jefferson, Klamath, Lake, Malheur and Wheeler counties).

Milk—14.4, 15.2, 16.4; eggs—51, 45, 53.
